4.1 Draw modus

The seeding and draw-en-bock will be made on Friday October the 13rd 2023. Immediately after the draw has been finalized, the categories will be made available online on the Sportdata Event Website. JJNOs have the right to request minor changes² in the following 2 hours, in writing, to the organizing committee.

Major changes³ must be requested according to the following⁴:

- At international events, no redraw is possible except for unforeseen cases when the OC may decide on a redraw.
- A redraw can be requested max. two hours after the draw was published, but, in any case, before the start of the competition, in writing, to the OC.

Seeding regulations of the JJIF will be observed. For the seeding, JJIF will use the world ranking list and registration for the event from October 13th 2023. The JJNOs are responsible for making sure all points are correct in the ranking list until this day.

6 Registration and Participation Fee

6.1 Participation Fee

95 \$ per individual athlete

Late entry and late payment fees will be applied.

- Change (of an injured) competitor until registration deadline: free
- Change (of an injured) competitor after registration deadline (in the same category): 10\$
- Change of the category of an athlete: 10\$
- Late entry: 10\$
- Additional entering of a competitor on site: 20\$

6.2 Financial conditions

The organization of the travel to the event and travel expenses are the responsibility of the participating countries. Each federation must pay the cost of the accommodation and the participation to local the organizer.

Payment must be done by cash at the official registration and accreditation. No accommodation or registration refund for participants not attending the Championship will be made.

Please note that the JJNOs must fulfil all financial obligations before the registration.

7 Anti-doping Control

All members should make their competitors aware that there could be doping control for several athletes. The WADA code for Doping Free sports will be applied. By entering the Championship, you accept the JJIF Anti-Doping regulations⁸.

If you are participating in the Championship and are taking any medication or plan to take any medication, please check with your doctor whether your medicine contains any substances on WADA's 2023 Prohibited List (<https://www.wada-ama.org/en/content/what-is-prohibited>)

You will need a Therapeutic Use Exemption (TUE) if it does. JJIF automatically recognizes all TUEs issued by National Anti-Doping Agency (NADAs), so don't hesitate to get in touch with your NADA if you need a TUE and do not already have one.

If you have any difficulty applying for a TUE through your NADO or there is no NADO in your country, don't hesitate to get in touch with the JJIF.

8 Competition Dressing and Personal Requirements & Advertising

Back Numbers⁹ will be sent to the national federation to be sewed on the official Gi. Please ensure to have the correct Gi.

Please note that during the Championship, no numbers on the back of the Gi are allowed unless specified by the organizer. Numbers on the back of previous tournaments must be removed from the Gi.

Please observe the regulations of the JJIF as far as advertising on the Gi is concerned¹⁰.

9 Referees

Application: Referees can register via SportsID for the event.

All referees will be waitlisted first.

Referee Attire

Referees must wear dark gray pants and black socks, a white short-sleeved shirt, a blue tie, and a blue jacket.

The Technical Commission (Head referee of Discipline) will decide about participation in consideration of Discipline [s], Availability, License level, Evaluation and Ranking, Gender equality aspects, country. Continental and age mix

10 Coaches & Medical personnel from JJNOs

10.1 Coaches

All official coaches should receive their accreditation cards during accreditation. Teams without an official coach will participate without coaching (no athlete or other officials will be allowed to enter the field of play unless they register as coaches). All Coaches should attend the briefing meeting (digital) on Saturday November 04th 2023).

10.2 Medical personnel

JJNOS may have its medical personnel. To receive an accreditation card as medical personnel the, attendance at the medical meeting¹¹ is mandatory.

10.3 Dress code

Coaches and medical personnel coming on the FOP must wear official team dresses¹²; shorts, flip-flops, hats are not allowed.

Filming (including mobile videos) inside the FOP is not allowed without press accreditation. According to GAISF guidelines, every competitor who has won a medal has to attend the ceremony to receive their trophy in person.

Due San José is experiencing a tourist boom, those interested in contracting the LOC accommodation, transportation and food package, and in order to guarantee spaces, every JJNO **must make the reservation by transferring the value of 1 (one) day of lodging and transportation expenses (USD 75.-) per person.** It is highly recommended to each National delegation to make the reservation as soon as possible, given that day by day the number of places available at the prices reported decreases.

Although it is not mandatory to contract the service offered by the JJNO, in case of opting for another, every JJNO will have to manage their transport and lodge by their own means.

Don't hesitate to contact the organizers concerning arrivals and provide them with exact information about your arrival and departure (means of transport, time and date of arrival and departure, flight number etc.), so they can organize everything on time.
